Al (Allie) Kittel's Creations

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
AL REDEFINES LEGACY

Allie Kittel had a progressive neuromuscular disorder, <u>Friedreich's Ataxia</u>, which shortened her life to 32 years. Nonetheless, she *has* left a lasting legacy – her <u>artistic creations</u> (archival prints of her paintings).

A LONG-LASTING, HIGH-QUALITY LEGACY

Her prints are expected to last 100 years, given they are printed on an acid-free 100% cotton cold-pressed material (not wood-based paper), using archival inks (12 different colors + 2 versions of black).

The printing company (<u>Graphic Sky Printing</u> in Santa Fe, NM) is the "go to printer" for serious painters, like Al. This summarizes the exceptional, methodical process used for each painting-to-print creation.
